- 1. The Boarding Home Parent must have a sincere interest in children and their education, a good understanding and appreciation of their ethnic, cultural and religious differences.
- 2. The Boarding Home Parent must provide adequate and comfortable sleeping arrangements (one or two students of same gender to a bedroom with single beds).
- 3. The Boarding Home Parent must provide well-balanced and nutritious meals required for the maintenance of good health.
- 4. The Boarding Home Parent must provide a quiet place with adequate lighting for the student to study.
- 5. The Boarding Home Parents must contact the student's worker or On-Call workers immediately if any serious problems arise.
- 6. The Boarding Home Parent must encourage the student to attend classes regularly and to complete assignments on time (the student should provide the Boarding Home Parent with their class schedule).
- 7. The Boarding Parent should treat the boarding student like their own child(ren).
