- Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care (MOHLTC) Advanced Care Paramedic Certificate.
- Valid CPR BLS (HCP) Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support (ACLS) Certification (an asset).
- Successful completion of Base Hospital certification
- Valid F driver's license with access to reliable transportation and a clear Driver's abstract.
- Up-to-date immunization records and N95 Mask Fit Testing.
- Clear Criminal Record Check, Vulnerable Sector Screening, and Child Abuse Registry check.
- Ability to work under stressful situations and exercise sound judgment.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Knowledge of indigenous Fire and Emergency Services (an asset).
- Understanding of Indigenous history, traditions, and beliefs; ability to implement cultural values and practices (an asset).
- Familiarity with Indigenous communities and organizations; experience working for an Indigenous organization.
