Position Overview:

As a Field Officer - Level 2, you'll play a vital role in enhancing the emergency response capacity of our communities. Working closely with local partners and supported by Indigenous Services Canada, you'll be at the forefront of emergency management, ensuring swift and effective responses to crises.

Responsibilities:

Emergency Management: Maintains Emergency Management/Operations proficiency in the areas of basic rural firefighting, first responder/first response, and emergency/incident management. Serves as an instructor and delivers training in these areas.

On-Call Readiness: Covers assigned on-call schedules and is prepared to deploy within 4-12 hours of being notified of an activation. Sets up and maintains a command post on arrival at an incident.

Community Partnerships: Maintains an ongoing, client-focused relationship with the relevant community departments and workers. Maintains knowledge of other local, regional, or provincial/federal emergency service/management providers and agencies.

Promotes Emergency Operations: Spread awareness and preparedness throughout our communities. From establishing communication channels to updating emergency plans, you'll ensure everyone is ready to face the unexpected.

Administrative Duties: Keep things running smoothly behind the scenes. From reports to budgeting, your organizational skills will ensure our operations remain efficient and effective.



Professional Expectations: Never stop learning. Attend workshops and training sessions to hone your skills, ensuring you're always at the top of your game. May be required to have cross training as part of Integrated Emergency Services and perform other duties as assigned by Director or designate.

Note: Flexibility is key at IFNA. You may occasionally cover tasks outside your role, ensuring comprehensive support for our organization's mission.

Position Requirements:

- Post-secondary education in emergency services or equivalent experience.
- Certifications required include CPR, First Responder and EMR, Instructor certifications for Fire Responder, Emergency Responder and Firefighter.
- Requires IMC/ICS 200 or above.
- 3 years of experience in emergency management that includes the areas of Prevention, Mitigation, Preparedness, Response and Recovery.
- Valid G driver's license and access to reliable transportation.
- Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Screening and Child Abuse Registry check.
- Knowledge of indigenous Fire and Emergency Service and Indigenous Services Canada.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills and ability to develop and maintain trust.
- Familiarity of Indigenous communities and organizations; experience working for an Indigenous organization.
- Understanding of Indigenous history, traditions, and beliefs; Ability to speak Ojibwe or Oji-cree
 is an asset.
